Course Description

Students will deepen their skill in Spanish in the areas of speaking, writing, reading, and aural comprehension. Special attention is given to developing cultural awareness. Students are not required to take the AP Exam. Another method for earning college credit is The Southern Oregon Foreign Language Articulation (SOFLA) Project which allows advanced high school students to earn university credit by demonstrating appropriate language proficiency.

All AP Spanish students will take a STAMP proficiency step in January to help determine which pathway they should take to earn college credit.
